

EQIP Health Support Services (EHSS)

EHSS offers students the opportunity to gain an entry-level qualification in the health care and social services field, while undertaking structured workplace experience to develop practical skills and experience in the field.

Health Care and Social Services is a high growth industry for employment opportunities. EQIP partners with Gladstone SHS, Toolooa SHS, and Tannum Sands SHS to provide year 11 and 12 students an opportunity to develop employability skills in this sector. Students participate in face-to-face training and work experience to apply the learning in authentic workplace environments. Students remain enrolled in school and attend training one day per week and may complete this program as a school subject.

Application and Selection Process

EQIP undertake a rigorous and consistent recruitment and selection process to ensure that students are the best fit for the program. When submitting the 'Expression of Interest' form, attach a student resume, 2 teacher references and the latest report card. Expression of Interest forms are available by visiting the EQIP website or contacting our office.

Costs

The student levy is reviewed annually to ensure that the levy is reasonable and can cover cost of the program. The qualification is on the Queensland Training Subsidies list and students participating in this program will complete the qualification fee-free. That is provided the students have not already used their one VETIS qualification fee-free funding.

Year 11 and 12 students commit 1 day per week during school term 2 and 3.
