

## QCS Test- Special Provision

There are two types of Special Provision that may be available for students for the QCS test.

### Before the Test

1. **Special Arrangements-** are practical adjustments to the test conditions (rest breaks, A3 size test materials, computer etc., extra time)
2. **Exemption-** allows a student to be absent from the test and remain eligible for an OP

### After the Test

1. **Absentee exemption-** allows a student who was unavoidably absent from the test to remain eligible for an OP
2. **Declaring a test grade null and void-** allows a student who sat the test to choose not to receive a test grade.

Applications need to be in by the 21<sup>st</sup> May and is available for students who may:-

- Have diagnosed dyslexia
- Have any impairments
- Is on medication that may require extra time
- Anxiety
- Medical Conditions
- May have a sporting event or extra-curricular event they have been selected for
